

# Coach Eligibility Requirements

## GUIDING PRINCIPLES

All athletes have the right to a [NCCP Certified](#) coach.

All coaches have the responsibility to:

- Have the required training to provide an environment that is physically, mentally, emotionally and socially safe for all athletes and participants.
- Have the required training to be able to provide a responsible learning environment that incorporates Dodgeball Ontario’s teaching methodologies, technical guidelines and long-term athlete development principles.
- Ensure that all training is current and updated as required, to be able to provide a safe and responsible sport experience for all.

## Mandatory Eligibility Requirements for Coaches:

Coaches listed on any Dodgeball Ontario tournament roster must complete the requirements in Section A to be eligible to participate. These requirements are mandatory for all Coaches regardless of certification status.

DEADLINE: Dodgeball Ontario’s registration deadline for the respective event.

SANCTIONS: Coaches who are missing any or all of the requirements in Section A will be ineligible to participate with their team in a Coach capacity at a Dodgeball Ontario tournament and will not be listed on the final team roster.
